A BILL FOR

- 1 An Act relating to courts of contest for disputed congressional
- 2 elections.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF IOWA:

- 1 Section 1. Section 60.5, Code 2021, is amended to read as 2 follows:
- 3 60.5 Organization and trial.
- 4 l. The clerk of the court shall, immediately after the
- 5 filing of the statement, notify the judges herein named, and
- 6 fix a day for the organization of the court within two days
- 7 thereafter, and also notify the parties to the contest. The
- 8 judges shall meet on the day fixed, and organize the court, and
- 9 make and announce such rules for the trial of the case as they
- 10 shall think necessary for the protection of the rights of each
- 11 party and a just and speedy trial of the case, and commence the
- 12 trial of the case as early as practicable thereafter, and so
- 13 arrange for and conduct the trial that a final determination
- 14 of the same and judgment shall be rendered at least six days
- 15 before the first Monday after the second Wednesday in December
- 16 next following, except as provided in subsection 2.
- 2. When the court hears a case for an election for a seat
- 18 in the United States senate or the United States house of
- 19 representatives, final determination and judgment shall be
- 20 rendered after such time as the court deems necessary for the
- 21 completion of the trial.
- 22 EXPLANATION
- The inclusion of this explanation does not constitute agreement with the explanation's substance by the members of the general assembly.
- 25 This bill relates to courts of contest organized to hear
- 26 contests for seats in the United States senate or the United
- 27 States house of representatives. The bill requires the
- 28 court to render a final determination and judgment after
- 29 such time as the court deems necessary for the completion of
- 30 the trial. Under current law, courts of contest for both
- 31 presidential electors and seats in congress must render a final
- 32 determination and judgment at least six days before the first
- 33 Monday after the second Wednesday in December.
